The Pilots Badge

The Pilots badge is not simply a logo, but is, in fact, full of meaning.

The logo is round:

God's love surrounds us all and envelops the whole planet.



In the boat is a cross:

Christ is the centre of the Church, the world and Pilots. The Cross stands at the centre of our lives giving stability and direction.



The sea is rough:

It reminds us of our life which has both smooth and rough patches.



Under the boat is a name:

The name on the badge is 'Pilots', expressing the organisation's unique identity.



On the sea is a boat:

These feature heavily in the Bible, especially in the ministry of Jesus. The ship is also the symbol of the World Council of Churches. This is a worldwide organisation which hundreds of different churches are part of.



In the sea is a fish:

The 'ichthus' (Greek for 'fish') symbol contains an acronym for Jesus, Saviour, Son of God in Greek, the language of the New Testament.
