

URC YOUTH LEADERS' GATHERING

The URC Youth leaders' Gathering will take place from 28 to 30 January 2022 at Whitemoor Lakes, near Lichfield, Staffordshire, and the event will run separately and alongside URC Youth Assembly 2022.

It's a gathering for all who work with young people aged 11 to 25 that are in any way connected with the URC (Volunteers and employed) in uniformed orangisations, Pilots, youth groups or any other setting.

Join us for a weekend connecting with other youth leaders across the URC:

- Gather to share your situations, stories, needs, dreams and ideas
- Gather to receive inspiration and resources for your ministry
- Gather for a time of reflections and worship, encouragement and fellowship
- Gather for some 1 to 1 mentoring support
- Gather to discover what the URC and URC Youth offers you and your young people.

The event will be in the same place and at the same time as URC Youth Assembly (the event for young people connected to the URC from Y10/S6 to age 26 inclusive), offering a separate event for youth leaders.

This is a wonderful opportunity to have a taste of URC Youth Assembly or even to bring young people along. URC Youth Assembly early-bird discount will be extended to 1 January 2022 for young people booked with a leader who is attending URC Youth Leaders' Gathering.

Whitemoor Lakes is a youth work venue, so accommodation is in small shared dormitory-style rooms with a mixture of single beds and bunks. All meals and refreshments are included. We will be running a creche for children aged up to 5 years old. There will be a coach provided from Tamworth station for those coming by train.

Cost: £115 for the weekend, inclusive.


