Training Session in Equality for All using the United Reformed Church Equal Opportunities Policy 2008

The intention of this outline is for use at a training session for Church or Elders Meeting or as part of a church training day.

The purpose of the day is to 'Take positive action to counter attitudes and practices contrary to this statement of intent' (Quotation from the Policy)

Opening Worship

Use the Introduction and the Statement of intent (para's 1 & 2) from the Equal Opportunities Policy 2008 to create opening worship, which sets the scene for the session. Give plenty of time for this.

Inclusive Community

Based on:

Build inclusive communities where all will be treated with dignity and respect and have equality of opportunity to contribute their gifts to the common life;

What does it mean to be or to build an inclusive community? Who are the "all" that are welcome? Put up the answers on a flipchart so that you can refer back to them throughout.

Discrimination

Get people into groups to discuss the following "What are the experiences of discrimination that you know of (personal or wider) from employment/community/church?"

All together share what people have learned from their discussion and then have a quiet space for reflection.

Positive Actions

Hand out the Policy Statement and ask the following. What positive actions can we take to reinforce this policy? *Come back to the flipchart answers.*

Hopefully, at the end, everyone will feel positive and there will be actions to take forward.
