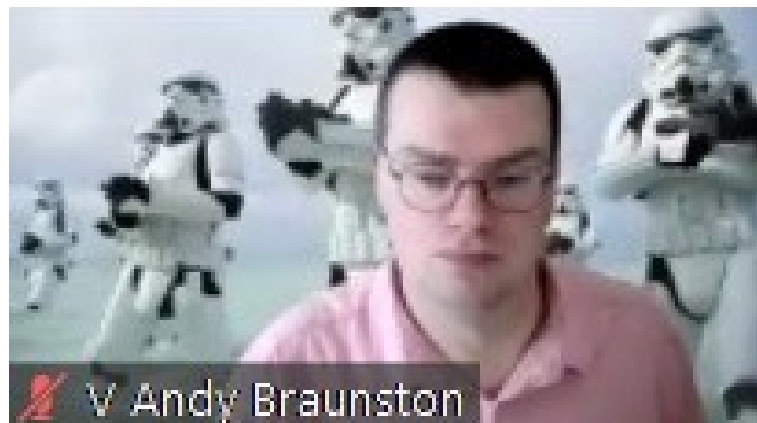


GAG hates to waste Assembly time [in producing another issue post-Assembly] but.....

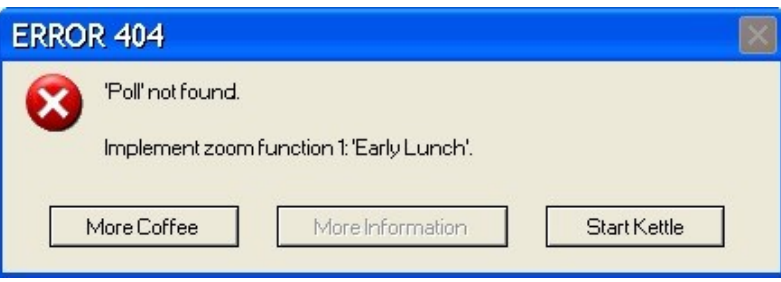

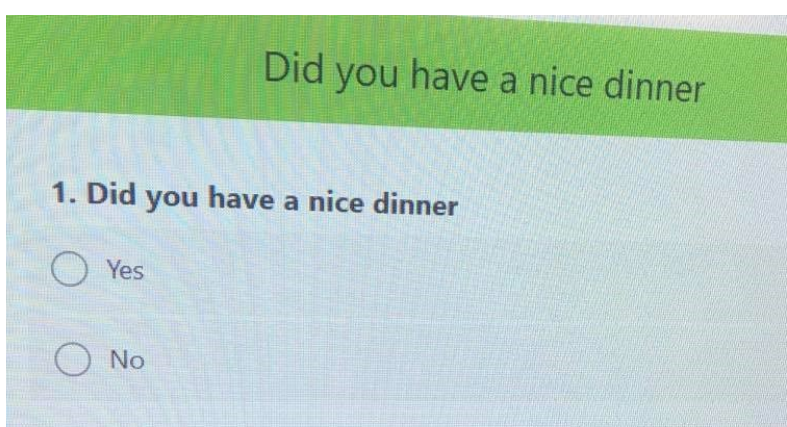
