## Ministries Committee APPEALS PROCEDURE

- If an applicant wishes to appeal against the decision of a sub-committee of the Ministries committee made in respect of the assessment process or in connection with a post accredited by a sub-committee of the Ministries Committee, the rules of procedure set out below shall apply.
- On receipt of the decision of the sub-committee, it shall be open to the applicant to request a hearing by the Ministries Committee. This hearing will be before a group from the Ministries Committee and will be chaired by the Convener or Deputy Convener of the Ministries Committee.
- 3 Such an application must be made to the Secretary for Ministries not more than 21 days after the date of the notification of the decision of the sub-committee to the applicant.
- The effect of an appeal shall be to stay the decision of the sub-committee concerned pending consideration of the matter by the Ministries Committee.
- An appellant shall have the right and may be required to appear at a meeting of the Ministries Committee when the matter is under review.
- 6 All appeals shall be accompanied by all relevant records and papers.
- Appellants shall be entitled to see such papers as they deem necessary in order to bring the subject of their appeal before the Ministries committee
- The Ministries Committee shall conduct the hearing of the appeal in the following order:
- 8.1 Call for and read minutes and papers relevant to the case
- 8.2 Hear the parties to the difference or dispute, viz.
  - (a) every appellant,
  - (b) the appointed representatives of the sub-committee whose decision is under question. Members of the Ministries Committee hearing the appeal shall have the opportunity to put questions to the parties through the presiding officer.
- 8.3 Consider and decide upon the matter in the absence of the parties
- Through the secretary, supply copies of the decision in writing to the parties within 7 days of the hearing.
- 9 There shall be no appeal from the decision of the Ministries Committee.
