Membership of General Assembly

Resolutions consequent on decisions taken by Mission Council in October 2012

At its meeting in October 2012, acting on the proposals of the Assembly Arrangements Committee, Mission Council decided that the number of representatives of partner churches overseas and of other denominations in the UK who are members of Assembly should each be reduced from twelve to six.

The relevant categories of membership in the Structure are 2(6)(g) and 2(6)(1):

- (g) Such number of representatives from the partner churches of the United Reformed Church outside of Britain and Ireland as the Assembly shall from time to time determine;
- (1) Representatives of other denominations in the United Kingdom as the General Assembly may from time to time determine;

It is now necessary formally to pass a resolution to this effect.
