AIM

This document tells you about one churches' development an Eco-congregation that has had an effect on their town and their opportunities for evangelism. You might like to try something similar.

INTRODUCTION

Some churches have been working towards 'Eco-Congregation' status. St Ives Free Church in Eastern Synod is one. This is their story:

Let me tell you: Mayor Presents Eco-congregation plaque to St Ives Free Church

On **20**th **March 2011** the Mayor of St Ives, David Hodge, attended a special service at the St Ives Free Church. He came to present a wooden plaque marking the award of ecocongregation status to the church.

The church set up an eco church group a couple of years ago. The group has been working both to make the church building more eco friendly and also encouraging individuals to consider a more sustainable lifestyle. The Eco-congregation Award is a national award given to churches that have worked through a churches environmental check-up, helped the whole congregation to make the link between their Christian faith and environmental concerns, taken practical action in the church, and had a positive impact on the wider community. In 2010 The Free Church was short listed for a Hunts Green Heart Community Award. There are regular displays in the Free Church giving information about green issues. Members of the church have visited the Hunts District Council's "Green House", attended the "Wave" demo in London held prior to the Copenhagen Climate Conference in December 2009, and the group has organised a variety of activities within the church.

As part of the celebration the church has produced its own Fairtrade and Eco-church cotton bag. The bags are made of Fairtrade cotton, and have been made by a fair trade woman's co-operative in India. St Ives Free Church is already a Fairtrade church and is well known in St Ives for its Fair Trade shop *Just Sharing* where the bags are on sale at £2.50 each.

Other churches have also found opportunities to have bags that can serve several purposes. As well as cutting down on the use of plastic carrier bags they can serve is opportunities for evangelism. Perhaps you have an event coming up where bags could be a useful resource. Maybe people could but the bags or maybe you might want to give bags away- some churches have been doing this. A church in Stockport gave a bag containing a hot cross bun and a leaflet about Easter services to commuters at the local railways station on Maundy Thursday last year.
